

INCONVENINCE PAYMENTS IN PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS POLICY

1. Introduction

ng homes is committed to the planned maintenance and improvement of its housing stock. The Association recognises that some internal works will cause a degree of disruption to our tenants. The purpose of this Policy is to provide a framework for calculation of a payment to be made to tenants where improvements or Mini-Modernisation works have been carried out to their home, by way of compensation for any inconvenience.

2. Calculation of Payment

The payment to tenants will be made in accordance with the following table.

3. Payment

Payment will be made to the tenant on completion of the works. Should the tenant have any outstanding rent arrears, rechargeable repair costs or other monies due to the Association these will be deducted.

n.b No money will be deducted from the payment for the District Heating System – payment will be made in all circumstances.
